20.102 PLANNING APPLICATIONS AND DECISIONS

a. RDC Ref: 20/00203/FULL

Proposal: Full Planning Permission for Alterations and Extensions to Existing Portal Framed Building including External Works for use as Builders Merchant (Sui Generis Use) Location: Coal Depot, Harmby Road, Leyburn, North Yorkshire, DL8 5ET

The Council has concerns over the traffic to the planned builder's merchant and how this would affect the Wensleydale Railway and the Garden Centre.

An increase in traffic particularly large HGV's raises the following concerns:

- Safety concerns for pedestrians using the railway and shoppers of the garden centre as this is both sides of the access road.
- Access for large deliveries/collections Is there enough room for HGV's to turn around within the yard? If not a large volume of reversing and turning vehicles would pose a risk to pedestrians and shoppers.

The Council would like assurance that vehicle speed along the access would be controlled. Arrangements would need to be put in place to ensure that deliveries are timed before the station and garden centre open with procedures to make certain HGV's can turn around safely.
