- 23.105 LIBRARY- We are pleased to report that the repair works in the Library are now complete and the Library is open. The Council gave thanks to the contractor Mr Andrew Foster and his team, they have done an excellent job.
- 23.106 MARKET TRADER APPLICATIONS The Council resolved to accept the application from Dreamtribe to become a permanent trader.
- **23.107 PLAY AREAS**
 - **a. Operational inspections-** The Council **resolved** to appoint Streetscape to complete the operational Play Area inspections.

23.108 THORNBOROUGH HALL

- a. Update All offices are now occupied.
- b. Office 8 –Cllr Sanderson confirmed that he had been out onto the roof and cleared the guttering at the front of the building as one of the outlets had been blocked causing the leak. The Council resolved to reimburse Clarkson's accountants for the damage to their blind and obtain quotations for the cleaning of the carpet.



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- **c. Cash Point** The Council discussed the enquiry from Barclays bank about possible locations for a cash point and hope that an alternative location can be found for this in central Leyburn.
- **d. Repair & paint windows-** The Council **resolved** to accept the revised quotation received from Mr Sean Taylor.
- 23.109 UTILITIES- The Council resolved not to take a 3 year fixed contract and will request prices for a 1 year contract. The management of all utility contracts and lining up of the contracts will be discussed again at a future meeting.

Action – Clerk to obtain quotes for one-year contracts and send to Councillors for discussion.

Action – Clerk to contact Yorvik Homes regarding the trees and grass cutting. Report the loose paving slabs to highways.

Cllr Holder updated the Council that the Jubilee Tree planted is thriving.
